

Exemption Data

The District offers various exemptions for qualifying taxpayers. The homestead exemption is the most common. To qualify for a homestead exemption, you must own and reside in your home on January 1 of the tax year and can be applied only to one property. The age 65 or older exemption or the disability exemption can only be applied to property with a homestead exemption and applicant must provide required documentation showing their qualification. This exemption also includes a tax limitation or ceiling. Some taxing entities such as the county offer the tax ceiling limitation.

All school districts offer a \$25,000 homestead exemption to qualified property owners and an additional \$10,000 for those over 65 years of age or those that are disabled that qualify.

Disabled Veterans are eligible for exemptions and those amounts are based on the percentage of their disability. These exemptions can apply to any one property.

RATING	Percentage	Amount
DV1	10 – 29%	\$5,000

DVHS applies only to General Homestead Exemption
